## ETS 'threat to Kwinana

HE might be small in stature, but Alan Eggleston has a big fight on his hands — killing off the Government's emissions trading scheme.

Senator Eggleston is chairman of the senate economics reference committee, which is scrutinising the carbon-pollution reduction scheme.

He said it would have diabolical

consequences for WA and the nation, and the Government should rethink its position.

“Australia produces 1.4 per cent of the world's emissions and we are introducing the most comprehensive, costly emissions trading scheme in the world,” he said.

“We could see the Kwinana (oil) refinery closing and moving to Singapore.”
